DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of the Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Can be used as a spray adjuvant with bluestone (copper sulfate pentahydrate) in the preparation of Bordeaux.

Other uses include: For domestic water treatment, for waste water treatment, for the control of odor from decomposing organic matter, the dehairing of animal hides, as a white wash, as a soil amendment, the manufacture of paper pulp, and for use as a coagulant/pH adjustor in assorted manufacturing processes.

NOTE: Western Lime is NSF certified to ANSI/NSF 60 Standards for use in the treatment of domestic drinking water. Maximum use for potable water treatment is 650 mg/l.
