**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For control of weeds and seedling grasses in established stands of perennial ryegrass and tall fescue in the State of Oregon.

Apply Diuron 4L in the Fall at a rate of 2 to 4 pints per acre to established stands of perennial ryegrass and at a rate of 4 to 8 pints per acre to established stands of tall fescue. Use sufficient water, a minimum of 25 gallons per acre, for thorough coverage of weed foliage. For best results, make applications at the onset of Fall rains and before weeds are established (typically, October 1 through November 15). Established weeds beyond the 2-to 4-leaf stage should be removed prior to treatment.

**NOTES**

- Apply only to well established, vigorous stands.
- Do not apply to perennial ryegrass less than 1 year old.
- Use mechanical agitator and avoid overlap of spray.
- Weed control may be reduced in fields where ash residues have accumulated from burning straw.
