GREEN CYPRESS ORGANIC SPREADER is a unique liquid wax adjuvant that is gentle on crops. It does not have the phytotoxic effect usually associated with crop oils. This product can be applied in combination with crop protection and/or nutrient products to improve their effectiveness. GREEN CYPRESS ORGANIC SPREADER fits well in an IPM program since it is easy on predaceous and beneficial species and honeybees.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read and follow the precautions, restrictions and recommendations on the labels of pesticides used with GREEN CYPRESS ORGANIC SPREADER. Use according to the most restrictive label directions for each product in any tank mix. NOT FOR AQUATIC USE.

COMPATIBILITY: GREEN CYPRESS ORGANIC SPREADER is compatible with most pesticides. However, if the desired combination has not been previously used, a compatibility test is recommended.

MIXING: Shake well before using. Fill spray tank ½ full of water and begin agitation. Add pesticides as directed by label or in the following sequence and continue filling tank: (1) Dry flowables or water dispersible granules, (2) Wettable powders, (3) Flowables, (4) Solutions, (5) Emulsifiable concentrates. Add GREEN CYPRESS ORGANIC SPREADER first and continue agitation until mixed. Continuous agitation of finished spray is recommended. If spray solution has been allowed to stand, thoroughly agitate and remix before application.

RECOMMENDATIONS: Specific use rates will vary with conditions of application such as water hardness, application method, equipment, spray droplet size, condition of foliage, etc. Do not exceed 1% concentration.

FOR CONCENTRATE OR DILUTE SPRAYS:

Use 8 to 24 fl. oz. per 100 gallons of spray solution. **NOTE:** For grapes, do not use after berry set.

FOR AERIAL, LOW VOLUME, OR CDA SPRAYS:

Use 6 to 16 fl. oz./acre or follow specific recommendations on the pesticide label.
