



# MONTEREY ZINC-ALL 7.5%

### GENERAL INFORMATION

MONTEREY ZINC-ALL 7.5% can be used for economical correction of zinc deficiency of vegetables, row crops, deciduous trees and vines, citrus and avocados, and turf and ornamental plants. MONTEREY ZINC-ALL 7.5% is formulated to be especially compatible with acidic solutions (pH lower than 7.0). It is effective when used in foliar sprays or in soil applications.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**SHAKE, STIR OR SWIRL CONTENTS BEFORE USING**

**MIXING:** Fill clean spray tank 1/3 - 1/2 full with water or liquid fertilizer. Add MONTEREY ZINC-ALL 7.5%, continue filling tank and thoroughly agitate the solution.

**NOTE:** MONTEREY ZINC-ALL 7.5% is slightly corrosive to non-stainless steels. Flush equipment with clean water after use.

**COMPATIBILITY:** MONTEREY ZINC-ALL 7.5% is compatible with most pesticides and fertilizers. Before tank mixing or use, check compatibility with a jar test of the product.

### SOIL OR DRIP IRRIGATION APPLICATIONS:

Broadcast or drip irrigate MONTEREY ZINC-ALL 7.5% according to crop need.

Mild Deficiency ..... 1 - 2 qts./acre  
Moderate Deficiency ..... 2 - 4 qts./acre  
Severe Deficiency ..... 1 - 3 gals./acre

For individual trees, apply 1/2 to 3 quarts per tree.

Applications with nitrogen-containing fertilizers may enhance results.

### FOLIAR APPLICATIONS:

MONTEREY ZINC-ALL 7.5% is recommended at the following rates and dilutions. However, it may be applied at lower rates, depending on crop condition.

Thorough coverage and wetting are needed for optimum foliar spray results. Actively growing plants with young leaves absorb foliarly applied MONTEREY ZINC-ALL 7.5% most efficiently. Immediate post-irrigation or post-rainfall applications give best foliar uptake. Addition of urea (for example, 5 lbs. Lo-Bi Urea per 100 gals. of spray solution) will enhance foliar uptake of MONTEREY ZINC-ALL 7.5%.

**AVOID** foliar applications of this product when plants are under moisture stress. **AVOID** foliar applications to deciduous tree crops during bloom.

**CAUTION:** Certain crop varieties may be sensitive to foliar applications of MONTEREY ZINC-ALL 7.5%. Test applications to part of the crop are advisable to assess the potential for undesirable effects under specific conditions.

**DILUTE APPLICATIONS:** Apply 1 to 12 quarts in at least 300 gallons of water.

**CONCENTRATE APPLICATIONS:** Use no more than 3 quarts of MONTEREY ZINC-ALL 7.5% in 25 gallons of water.

**AERIAL APPLICATIONS:** Use no more than 1 quart of MONTEREY ZINC-ALL 7.5% in 5 gallons of water.

**OVERHEAD SPRINKLER FERTIGATION:** Inject the recommended dose into at least 1/16 acre inch of irrigation water.
