GENERAL INFORMATION

MICRO BLEND is a liquid blend of metal sulfates that is readily available and rapidly absorbed by the root system. A use rate of 1/2 to 1 gallon per acre will usually correct most trace element deficiencies. These deficiencies usually occur when plants are small; therefore, trace elements should be added to pre-plant fertilizer, if possible.

MICRO BLEND can be mixed with almost all liquid fertilizers and nutrients including seeding, pre-plant, side-dress, banding and water runs via sprinkler irrigation.

MICRO BLEND can be applied to all crops, including vegetables, row and field crops, feed crops, trees, vines, ornamentals and turf.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

COMPATIBILITY: MICRO BLEND is compatible with almost all fertilizers and other plant nutrients, as well as pesticides. However, if the desired combination has not been previously used, a compatibility test is recommended.

APPLICATION METHOD: MICRO BLEND is designed for soil application. Broadcast or row applications are acceptable, although greater efficiency may be expected from row applications. It is formulated to be used in liquid fertilizer, but may be used by itself.

Washington State law requires that EPA-approved safety devices be in use when this product is used through any irrigation system. Do not chemigate if wind speed exceeds 10 mph.

MICRO BLEND can also be coated on dry blend fertilizer to control dust in the blend plant and supply needed micronutrients.

MIXING: Shake, stir, or swirl contents before using. Always add this product to the spray tank before adding other agricultural chemicals. If mixing permits, allow agitation of the solution in tank to insure uniform mixing.

The addition of agricultural surfactant to MICRO BLEND will improve initial deposits, redistribution and uptake.

APPLICATION RATES: Apply the following rates if you do not have a soil or leaf analysis:

- Maintenance Application 1 quart per acre
- Moderate Deficiency 2-4 quarts per acre
- Severe Deficiency 1-2 gallons per acre

Mixed With Macronutrients: Apply 1/2 to 1 gallon per acre mixed with the liquid nutrients. Add MICRO BLEND to a partially filled tank and continue filling.

Transplanting or Cutting: Mix 1/2 gallon of MICRO BLEND per 20 gallons of solution.
