GENERAL INFORMATION

MONTEREY CAL-NITE is recommended for use on field, row, vegetable, fruit, tree, vine and ornamental crops. MONTEREY CAL-NITE is specifically designed for both foliar and soil applications to economically correct calcium deficiency in plants. Because calcium deficiency is associated with bloom and fruiting malformations, pre-bloom applications are generally most effective. Certain crops, primarily vegetables, can benefit from repeated applications throughout the growing season.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE — GENERAL

SHAKE, STIR OR SWIRL CONTENTS BEFORE USING.

Soil applications of MONTEREY CAL-NITE are recommended at planting or transplanting. Actively growing plants with young leaves absorb foliarly-applied MONTEREY CAL-NITE most efficiently. Immediate post-irrigation or post-rainfall applications give best foliar uptake.

Avoid foliar applications (especially to vegetables) of this product when plants are under moisture stress.

COMPATIBILITY: MONTEREY CAL-NITE is compatible with most pesticides and fertilizers. Before tank mixing or use, check compatibility with a jar test of the products. Avoid mixtures with zinc, manganese or ferrous sulfates.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE — SPECIFIC

FIELD CROPS, ROW CROPS, VEGETABLES: Apply 1 quart MONTEREY CAL-NITE per acre in 10 gallons of water by air, or 50-100 gallons by ground. Repeat applications at 10-14 day intervals if necessary for correction of calcium deficiency.

TREE AND VINE CROPS, INCLUDING CITRUS AND DECIDUOUS TREES: Apply 1-3 quarts MONTEREY CAL-NITE per acre in 100 gallons of dilute spray. For concentrate sprays, apply 1-2 quarts product per acre in 50-150 gallons of water. Repeat as needed at 10-14 day intervals.

DRIP IRRIGATION OF NURSERY STOCK AND OTHER CROPS: Apply 1-2 gallons MONTEREY CAL-NITE per acre at 3-4 week intervals. Use the lower rate for nursery stock.
