GENERAL INFORMATION

MONTEREY ZM-NITE is recommended for use on field crops, vegetables, row crops, deciduous trees and vines and evergreens such as citrus and avocados. MONTEREY ZM-NITE is designed for foliar and soil applications to economically correct manganese and zinc deficiencies in plants.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE — GENERAL

SHAKE, STIR OR SWIRL CONTENTS BEFORE USING.

Soil applications of MONTEREY ZM-NITE are recommended at planting or transplanting. Actively growing plants with young leaves absorb foliarly-applied MONTEREY ZM-NITE most efficiently. Immediate post-irrigation or post-rainfall applications give best foliar uptake.

Avoid foliar applications of this product when plants are under moisture stress. Avoid foliar applications to deciduous tree crops during bloom.

COMPATIBILITY: MONTEREY ZM-NITE is compatible with most pesticides and fertilizers. Before tank mixing or use, check compatibility with a jar test of the products.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE — SPECIFIC

FIELD CROPS: Apply recommended dose in 5-20 gallons of water by air, or a minimum of 20 gallons by ground.

Cereals (Wheat, Oats, Barley, Rye): Apply 1-2 quarts per acre before heading. DO NOT graze within 7 days after application.

Corn: Apply 1-2 quarts per acre at the 6-8 leaf stage.

Cotton: Apply 1-2 quarts per acre before squaring.

VEGETABLES: Apply recommended dose in 5-20 gallons of water by air, or a minimum of 20 gallons by ground.

Beans: Apply $\frac{3}{4}$ -1 $\frac{1}{2}$ gallons per acre prior to bloom.

Celery: Apply 2-3 gallons per acre at 6"-8" height.

Potatoes: Apply $\frac{3}{4}$ -1 $\frac{1}{2}$ gallons per acre at tuber development.

TREE CROPS: Apply recommended dose in 5-20 gallons of water by air, or in a minimum of 20 gallons by ground.

Apples, Pecans, Prunes, Walnuts: Apply 1-2 quarts per acre.

Citrus: Apply $\frac{1}{2}$ - 1 gallon per acre.
