PAL™ modifies the surface soil chemistry to allow for better water penetration, better soil aeration, and better nutrient utilization.

PAL™ may help reduce the sticking of soil to potatoes at harvest when applied in the last irrigation.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Apply PAL™ only through an irrigation system.

This product is most effective when applied starting with the first irrigation of the season.

DO NOT APPLY with Phosphorus containing products.

APPLICATION RATE

FIRST IRRIGATION : Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acre.

SUBSEQUENT IRRIGATIONS : Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acre every 20 to 30 days. Apply more frequently as irrigation quantity increases. Apply as soon as permeability starts to decrease.

Washington State law requires that an EPA-approved safety device be in use when this product is used in any irrigation system.

COMPATABILITY STATEMENT

DO NOT APPLY with Phosphorus containing products.

Conduct a small scale test for compatibility before combining this product with other agricultural products in a full size batch.
