GENERAL INFORMATION

SEQUESTAR 11% IRON CHELATE is a fully chelated, water soluble, powdered form of iron DTPA and is recommended for the prevention and correction of iron deficiency in crops. The preferred use is as a soil application to prevent the deficiency although it may also be used as a foliar spray to provide correction when a soil application is impractical.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SOIL APPLICATION: SEQUESTAR 11% IRON CHELATE is recommended for use on acid and mildly alkaline soils. To ensure uniform coverage, SEQUESTAR 11% IRON CHELATE should be dissolved in water or fluid fertilizer, or dry blended with water soluble fertilizers. For trees or individual plants, the chelate may be blended with an inert (such as soil or sand) or sprinkled directly on the soil uniformly under the plant's drip line, then watered in. Soil applications may also be made by dissolving in water and then mixing or metering into drip, sprinkler or furrow irrigation systems.

FOLIAR APPLICATION: SEQUESTAR 11% IRON CHELATE may be applied in water or in combination with most pesticides. After the correct dilution has been made, the spray solution should be buffered to pH 6-6.5. Thorough coverage and the use of wetting agents often enhance nutrient uptake from foliar sprays. Application rates and dilution factors depend on crop sensitivity, the amount of foliage to be sprayed and the application method. Avoid applying this product when plants are suffering from moisture stress. If there is any doubt, apply the spray solution to a small test area of the crop or foliage to assess any undesirable effects or phytotoxicity before general application.

AERIAL APPLICATION: Apply 1/4 pound of SEQUESTAR 11% IRON CHELATE per acre in at least 10 gallons of water. For application timing and frequency, refer to appropriate foliar application recommendation below.

For the agronomic application rates suitable for your geographical area or the maximum allowable non-nutrient application rates per acre, consult a trained soil specialist or write to Monterey AgResources.

SOIL APPLICATION RECOMMENDATIONS

VEGETABLE CROPS including beans, celery, cucumbers, lettuce, melons, onions, peas, peppers, potatoes, sweet corn, tomatoes:	2½ to 7½ lbs. per acre
FIELD CROPS including alfalfa, corn, dry beans, peas, forage grasses, rice, safflower, sorghum, sugar beets, sugarcane:	2½ to 7½ lbs. per acre
TREE AND VINE CROPS including almond, apple, apricot, avocado, berry, cherry, citrus, grape, mango, olive, pear, peach, pistachio, plum, walnut:	2½ to 10 lbs. per acre or ½ to 2½ oz. per inch of tree diameter
ORNAMENTAL SHRUBS AND TREES including azaleas, gardenias, junipers, pines, roses:	4 tsp. for small shrubs and up to 4 tsp. per inch of tree diameter for large trees and shrubs
TURF:	1 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. or 40 lbs. per acre

The rates given in the table above are based on broadcast application. If broadcast rates are used for spot or banded applications, phytotoxicity may result.

FOLIAR APPLICATION RECOMMENDATIONS

TREES (CITRUS):	Apply 1 to 2 lbs. per 100 gallons of cover spray any time except during bloom.
TREES & VINE CROPS (excluding citrus):	Apply 1 to 2 lbs. per acre in sufficient spray volume for thorough coverage (25 gal. minimum) at dormant/delayed dormant before bloom, then after full bloom at 2 to 3 week intervals as needed. NOTE: For smooth skinned fruit (peach, pear, apple, etc.) apply 1 lb. per acre in 50-100 gal. of water.
VEGETABLE & FIELD CROPS (ground eqpt.):	Apply 1/3 to 1-1/3 lbs. per acre in sufficient spray volume for thorough coverage (25 gallon minimum).
TURF:	Apply 1-5 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. in sufficient spray volume for thorough coverage. With growth regulators, apply 1-4 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft.
